EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 50

**SCALING UP OF MONITORING AND IMPLEMENTATION OF
PROTOCOLS AND TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS**

WHEREAS, there has been a consistent rise in the number of new cases of COVID-19 in the Country;

WHEREAS, the possibility of the spread of the virus in Mariveles which includes the new variants is of high probability considering the distinct situation of Mariveles which hosts the Freeport Area of Bataan, and two designated COVID-19 facilities;

WHEREAS, there is a need to intensify the implementation of existing health standards and protocols to minimize the possibility of the repeat of the surge of cases in Mariveles in 2020;

WHEREFORE, in the interest of Public Health and the General Welfare of the People of Mariveles, it is hereby decreed:

Section 1. Declaration of Curfew. A curfew in the entire Municipality of Mariveles is hereby declared from of 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. for non-essential personnel on the streets;

Section 2. Exemption from Curfew. The following are hereby declared from the above mentioned curfew:

- a) Health care workers and frontliners;
- b) Peace and order officers
- c) Workers from the night shift of the Processing zones, and other commercial establishments allowed to operate during the period of the curfew, with valid ID's, and
- d) LGU officers.

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Section 3. Restriction on Restaurants and Commercial Establishments. Restaurants shall continue to implement social distancing for dine in customers and observe minimum health protocols of requiring face mask, face shield from all customers, and shall provide hand sanitizers for the customers.

All commercial establishments engaged in wholesale and retail selling and buying of goods will be required to strictly implement the same minimum health protocols mentioned above;

Section 4. Check Point Protocols. The following documents shall be required at the check point:

All returning residents of Mariveles, must present a valid government issued ID at the check point to prove that they are residents of Mariveles.

For non-residents of Mariveles, they must present the following:

1. For APOR's - Company issued ID or proof of identity as an APOR;
2. For Tourists
 - i. Residents of Bataan - Government Issued ID
 - ii. Non-Residents
 - a. Government Issued ID
 - b. Medical Certificate issued by physician from place of origin; and
 - c. Proof of booking or reservation of establishment in Mariveles;

Section 5. Ban on entry into Mariveles, Bataan during the Holy Week Break. From March 29 to April 4, 2021, only residents of Mariveles, and Tourists with prior booking and registration will be allowed entry in Mariveles. Provided that, Frontliners, Health Workers, APORs, Essential workers and traveller's engaged in food delivery and services shall be exempted from this restriction;

Section 6. The Mariveles Philippine National Police, the Public Safety Office, and the Municipal Disaster and Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO), and Municipal Health Office (MHO) are directed to immediately implement this Executive Order.



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


Section 7. Violators of this Executive Order will be prosecuted under R.A. 11332, when applicable.

Section 8. Effectivity. This executive order shall take effect immediately upon publication.

Section 9. Separability Clause. If any of the portions of this issuance will be declared unconstitutional, or contrary to existing National Laws, the portions hereof not so declared will remain in force and effect.
